REGULATIONS SECTION 2.3**

**WHEREAS**, The Round Mountain Water and Sanitation District (District) in accordance with section 32-11001(1)(m) of the Colorado Revised Statutes has the authority to amend existing Rules and Regulations when deemed necessary by the Board of Directors; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has determined that it is necessary to amend Section 2 (2.3) establishing a requirement for applicants of connection permits to provide a valid excavation permit before purchase.

ROUND MOUNTAIN WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT, COLORADO THAT:**

Effective January 1, 2024, The amendment of the District's Rules and Regulations "Section 2 (2.3) as attached to this resolution be adopted and implemented.

## **RMWSD RULES AND REGULATIONS SECTION 2(2.3) AMENDMENT**

**The following paragraph shall be inserted between the existing paragraphs three and four of section 2(2.3):**

“Applicants requesting to purchase connection permits from the District must provide the District a valid excavation permit issued from the appropriate municipality or county (Westcliffe, Silver Cliff, Custer County) that governs the location of the tap installation before the purchase can be completed. Connection permits will not be sold without the issuance of a valid excavation permit.”
